

Annual Events

Open House (August)

- Students are invited to meet their teachers, see their classrooms, and take their school picture.

New Family Orientation (August)

- New families are invited to a special evening where they can connect with school leadership, meet their teachers, and take their school picture.

Athletic Orientation Meeting (August)

- All athletes and parents are highly encouraged to attend this meeting to review athletic policies & forms and to connect with the coaches.

High School & Middle School Orientation (May or August)

- Incoming 9th graders are invited to a special evening where they register for classes and learn more about high school.
- Incoming 6th graders and parents are invited to a special meeting where they learn more about middle school.

Middle and High School Retreat (September)

- These parent/community led events are intended to build community and deepen our student's relationship with Jesus. Middle School Retreat is typically a 1-2 day event held at a local host site. High School Retreat is typically a 2-3 day event held at the Lake Geneva Christian Center near Alexandria, MN.

Ecology Trip (October)

- This opportunity is offered to students who take Ecology and provides a 3-day experience up north to enhance their classroom learning.

Harvest Festival (November)

- This is one of our largest fundraisers of the year and includes many activities and booths, as well as live and silent auctions.

Washington DC Trip (November)

- This trip is offered to our senior students who take Government class and provides an opportunity to extend the classroom learning experience to our nation's capital.

Fall and Spring Parent-Teacher Conferences (November/February)
