



DUAL ACTIVITY PARTICIPATION FORM

The board of CMCS has adopted the following policy regarding students who wish to participate in “dual activities” during the same sports season, regardless of whether they are individual or team sports.

If a student desires to participate in two activities during the same season, they must do the following:

1. Obtain permission from his/her parents to compete in two activities at the same time.
2. Request permission from the coaches of the two activities he/she is hoping to compete in.
3. Complete the “Dual Activity Participation Contract” (*on reverse side*) and return to the Athletic Director.

It is our goal to have continuous communication between the students, coaching staff, and athletic department to avoid putting the student in a difficult situation. Participation in more than one activity per season may not be the best situation for every student. For this reason, clarity and understanding between all parties involved is vitally important.

The student-athlete must declare a priority activity. The priority order will be as follows:

1. Naturally, if only one activity is practicing/meeting, the student will attend.
2. If both activities are practicing/meeting, the tie goes to the priority activity.
3. If one activity has an event (meet, match, game, performance etc.) and the other is practicing/meeting, the tie goes to the activity with an event.
4. If both activities have events, the tie goes to the priority activity.
