- Apply in FACTS Financial Portal using your 2023 taxes and complete all questions that help determine financial need (\*there is a \$45 fee to apply)
- FACTS verifies information
- · Award is emailed to family

The financial aid process is streamlined for those who apply. Below you will find the financial variables considered in our FACTS system.

Financial aid is awarded based on need, and may cover up to 65% of tuition cost.
